- 1. Lumens 3W/260 Lumens (LED Lantern) / 5W/580 Lumens (Side COB)
- Battery Type 2x 18650 / 1200mAh each
- 3. Usage Time when Fully Charged 4.5 Hours (LED Lantern at High Mode) / 3 Hours (COB Both On)

Operation & Charging:

- 1. Press the Do button and switch light modes for LED lantern -Press 1x - High Mode / Press 2x - Low Mode / Press 3x - Flash Mode / Press 4x - Off.
- 2. Press the 'O' button and switch light modes for side COB lights -
- Press 1x Left COB on/ Press 2x Both sides on / Press 3x Off.
- 3. Do not use a different type of the rechargeable battery to avoid danger. Recharge the battery when lights begin to dim to avoid deep discharge.
- 4. Use the included Type-C / USB-A charging cable for charging. The indicator lights will flash while it's charging.
- Four indicator lights will become solid blue when fully charged. Charge before first use.
- For charging, please use a USB adaptor with 5V/1000mAh charging current.
